The event was organized by the Students' Scientific Association of the Medical University of Silesia, in collaboration with the Polish Association of Dental Students and the Doctoral Students' Government of the Medical University of Silesia.

This year's congress featured a record number of 293 oral presentations, delivered by participants from multiple countries and academic institutions (Details available in Attachment No. 1.). A total of 68 projects were recognized with awards by the Scientific Committee, based on their scientific merit, clarity of presentation, and innovation (Details available in Attachment No. 2.).

In addition to the scientific sessions, 13 practical workshops were organized, covering a wide range of topics in clinical skills, research methodology, and personal development.

All conference sessions, including oral presentations, were streamed and recorded, and are available for public viewing via the ŚUMKatowice YouTube channel.
